

In Case of Emergency Dial 911 (Medical, Fire, Law Enforcement)

Make sure you have reached Iron County Central Dispatch (ICCD).

If you have not, ask them to transfer you to Iron County.

Response time may vary depending on other emergencies occurring at same time.

What 3 Words:

Emergency Details: Provide as much information as possible about the emergency. Patient name, sex and age, list of allergies and medications etc.

Law Enforcement: Response will be from Iron county sheriff's deputy or state trooper, depending on who is closer.

How to find What 3 Words:

What3words application allows dispatch to help locate you.

Every 3-meter square is given a unique combination of three words. It is the easiest way to find and share exact locations and it is simple to use.

1. Download the application on your cell phone.
2. Open the app. Wait a few seconds for the blue dot to settle in one place.
3. Locate yourself. Tap your location and the 3 words will display at the top of the screen.
4. Give the 3 words to the dispatcher. Read or text what3words location over the phone.

911 test calls:

Call (906-875-4425) first to explain you will be making the test call.

You are welcome to make a test call from your residence in order to see if your phone will provide accurate location information.

Gate lock: You can call (906-875-4425) if you have a gate lock and would like a lock code associated with your address for responders.
